At the December meeting we all joined in some Christmas yummies and there was a good spread—thank you to everyone who bought in items for us all to share.

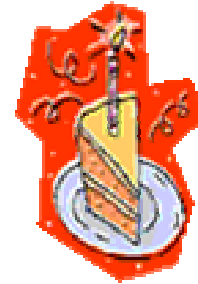
Kevin briefly outlined the success of the Autumn Fair in November and gave details of our Spring Fair

with or where to place—what better place than the attic!!

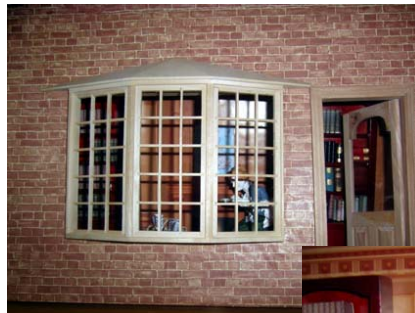
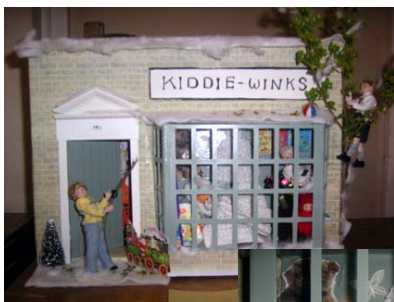
It will be interesting to see who the organised and dis-organised people are! I know which one I am!
